was a former shoulder strap factory from the 19th century



Living in Rouen

Housing options

ENSA Normandie does not have student housings, however owners often send us available flats or rooms to rent out and incoming students can also find a flat or room via the school's Facebook page or on le boncoin or marketplace.

Living expenses

- About 750 € per month
- Reasonably priced accommodation: for a 25 m2 studio in Rouen the minimum rent is 350 €, in Paris 650 € (Le Bon Coin website in February 2020).
