ENSA Normandie Welcome!



Founded in 1903, the ENSA Normandie is the only architecture school within the norman territory and is a member of the network of 20 architecture schools accredited by the Ministry of Culture in France. The school was established in 1984 in Rouen and Darnétal, in a former factory, witness of the late 19th century architecture.

Within a 2.5 hectare park, the school provides 6000 square meters dedicated to teaching architecture and is home to around 700 students. By the end of 2023, additional 500 square meters will be dedicated to research. The school's objective is to lead an active pedagogy by combining the teaching of theoretical knowledge and practice throughout group work or thematic workshops. In order to best prepare the students for the professional world. ENSA Normandie has taken up the current territorial issues and the diversity of contemporary practice: environment, transformation of the existing, climate change and eco-materials.

Master program

The Master's degree is a foursemester program leading to a graduate degree (Diplôme d'État d'architecte - DEA). It is a cycle dedicated to reinforcing knowledge in the design of an architectural and urban project, by understanding the complexity of societal, economic and environmental issues, and by organizing their critical mind. Three fields of specialization are available: Experimentation, Cities and Territories Architecture, and Trans-Form, Building with the Existing.

DRAQ course - Master in Civil
Engineering with the University of
Le Havre Normandie

The Diagnosis and Rehabilitation of everyday Architecture course (DRAQ) within the Civil Engineering Master's degree is a two-semester program of scientific specialization focused on the analysis of old or modern buildings as well as on the architectural and technical rehabilitation project. According to their original training, the students graduate with a DRAQ master's degree, with a major in architecture or engineering, delivered by the University of Le Havre, Civil Engineering Department.

Post DEA

The habilitation to practice project management in its own behalf (HMONP) is a professional diploma allowing the certified architect to register with the Order of Architects and to practice project management.

The doctorate in architecture with the University of Rouen Normandy

The doctorate in architecture leads to a postgraduate degree. The doctorate student works on a thesis in the school's Architecture, Territory, Environment laboratory (ATE).

The doctorate in research and creation (Radian)




An international outreach

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Living in Rouen and in Normandy

Rouen benefits from the attractiveness of a large city while being a city on a human scale. This unique and vivid metropolis is home to 500,000 inhabitants including 45,000 students. Located at 1,5 hours from Paris, Rouen is an imposing cultural capital with a prestigious architectural heritage and multiple museums. Major national and international events take place in Rouen such as the Armada and the Normandy Impressionist Festival. It is also a candidate for the European Capital of Culture title for 2028. The city, ENSA Normandie and Normandie University provide several support services for the arrival of international students (housing assistance, visa

or residence permit, health center, etc.). Rouen also has an efficient public transportation network that enables easy access to other interesting locations such as Mont-Saint-Michel (Unesco World Heritage Site), Le Havre, Caen, Étretat, etc. The Normandy coast is only one hour away by train or car.
