





Recruitment of 4 guest professors for the spring semester 2025

Each year, ENSA Normandie recruits 4 invited professors to conduct architectural, urban or landscape design studios during the last semester of the bachelor's degree program. These invited professors provide 120 hours of supervision for a group of twenty students, and also give during the semester a Masterclass lecture open to all the students of the architecture school.

Profile and purpose

Candidates must have a strong professional or academic background in architectural, urban and/or landscape design. They are invited to make a proposal for an innovative and exploratory studio that would stand out from the existing bachelor degree curriculum. In this context, the aim is to work with students on design methods and issues which aren't usually addressed within the school of architecture. It is planned that at least one of the four studios will be taught in English.

Conditions

Candidates are required to provide evidence of professional activity in architecture and/or teaching or research duties in a higher education research establishment, either in France, Europe or abroad.

They must also be qualified architects, urban planners or landscape architects.

Contract terms

Effective date of recruitment: March 1st 2025 for a period of 6 months.

Remuneration : on the basis of the increased index of the 1st step of the ENSA professors' corps, i.e. a net monthly salary of €1,970 (€11,820 in total).

Teachers are responsible for their own travel and accommodation costs.

Hierarchical authority: director of ENSA Normandie

The teachers recruited are expected to work closely with the semester coordinators to ensure that their teaching fits in with the rest of the semester.

Recruitment procedure

Launching of the call for application : July 1^{st} 2024

Deadline of application: September 15th 2024

Selection on document and audition of the candidates: end of September 2024

Transmission of the selected application to the Ministery of Culture for recruitment: October 11th 2024

Application file (in French or in English)

- Curriculum vitae
- A portfolio of professional and/or academic publications, if any.

- Pedagogical note of 4 pages maximum with :
 - a suggestion for the project workshop, setting out its theme and method, specifying its organization, a
 provisional timetable and, if applicable, a provisional budget for visits and the purchase of teaching
 materials. It will be possible to supervise the workshop once a week from March to early June, or twice
 a week in May and June;
 - a suggestion of subject for a Masterclass conference and a provisional title;
 - a note on your schedule constraints that could affect the organisation of the teaching.

Documents to be provided if the application is accepted, if applicable

- Scan of your social security card or social security certificate
- Identity card or passeport
- Curriculum vitae
- Documents proving that you have a principal activity that provides you with a regular income (pay slips and contracts or business start-up and tax notice or micro-business income statement or balance sheet, etc.).
- Every useful document attesting experience in link with the discipline taught.
- National service identification card or certificate of participation in the "journée de défense et citoyenne" (defence and citizenship day)
- Bank details with IBAN and BIC

For foreign nationals:

- All of the above documents or equivalents, in French or in the original language with sworn translation attached :
- Additional documents to submit :
 - Residence permit valid as work permit for non-EU nationals OR work permit;
 - Document certifying that you are in compliance with national service obligations in your country of origin;
 - Equivalent of an extract from the criminal record (bulletin N° 2) or, by default, a sworn statement.
